1. Overview

2. Information We Collect

Information You Provide

We may collect personal information you voluntarily provide, including:

Automatically Collected Information

4. Cookies and Analytics

We do not sell, rent, or trade your personal information to third parties for their marketing purposes.

5. Data Sharing

- With service providers (e.g., email platforms, hosting providers) who assist us in operating the Site, under confidentiality agreements
- When required by law, court order, or governmental authority
- To protect the rights, property, or safety of Inventory, our clients, or others

We retain personal information only as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes described in this policy or as required by applicable law. Project-related correspondence may be retained for the duration of the business relationship and a reasonable period thereafter.
